






















Lake Mattamuskeet

1585: ~120,000 ac.

1789: 1st attempt to drain failed

1837: Landfall Landing Canal drains lake down to ~55,000 ac.

1914-17: Outfall Canal dredged; pump plant built—failed to drain

lake

1920: attempt to drain failed

1925: pumps rebuilt; lake completely drained

1932: pumps fail after heavy rains, lake fills, farm shutdown

1934: lake purchased by US

Today: ~40,000 ac.




