• NAILING YOUR EXPOSURES

Proper exposure is critical to the photographic process, but for many is a challenging concept to understand and apply. We will photograph in the field and simplify the process of getting the right exposure. You will also learn why shooting in manual mode is not as difficult as you might think. At the end of the field session, we will have the opportunity to review images.

### **COMPETITIONS**, submitted by Neva Scheve

Due to a technical glitch in the sound and light system in the school auditorium, our August **Insects and Arachnids** competition slideshow was almost cancelled. But, thanks to our great SPC technical crew and the O'Neal school troubleshooter, we were able to set up in the lobby of the building and the show went on.

Our judge Susan Bailey was not able to attend the meeting, but she supplied us with thoughtful comments and scores. Congratulations to the winners.

This was an interesting competition for us. Two days before the upload deadline, we had very few images entered, but then on the last two days, we received about 85% of the total images entered. Class B really stepped up. There were 32 photos entered in Class B by the deadline. Class A had 19 entries, much fewer than usual. Class C only had 9 entries, so we were only able to award a first and second place.

After the slideshow we opened up the meeting for some discussion of Class C. Members were able to ask the photographers how some of the photos were edited and why they qualified for Class C. Some photos looked like they could have been entered into Class A or B and members were curious why they were entered in Class C. In those cases, backgrounds or major elements had been replaced or the photo had elements cut out and put back together. Others were simply edited with more software than is allowed in the other classes. Then, of course there were those photos that were much more creatively edited and obviously should have been entered in Class C. Hopefully, we were able to clarify a bit more what kind of image qualifies for Class C. An image does not HAVE to look like it has been creatively edited, but if the photographer has made changes that go over the editing rules for Classes A and B, it belongs in Class C even if it looks like nothing was done. Of course extensive creative editing is not only allowed, but encouraged. Almost anything goes.

The next competition is "**Clouds** – *The Essence of the photo should be clouds*" The galleries will open at 4:00 Sunday, September 11 and close at 4:00 Sunday, September 18. A blast will be sent before the opening date with the upload links. The competition will be judged by a panel of three advanced SPC members, **Linda Piechota, Jill Margeson,** and **Betty Hendrix**. Happy shooting.
