March 11 - "Architecture and Drama" - Henry Rinne



Henry will be with us at the Horticultural Center for this presentation so please come and enjoy!

.....So why do I photograph architecture? A building's dramatic form narrates a story, and I look to reveal this

narrative in the buildings I photograph.
Some structures are simply monumental

forms—a monumentality that must be conveyed through the image. Other forms are mysterious. Their tales are present but elusive to our sensibilities. Something is hidden behind the facade, and contrast brings out the impact of the forms and their sensuality. Since structures are made to be used and provide





context to people's lives, I try to create an image that resonates with the narrative of human life. The talk centers on my architectural photographs including a look at my process for creating the images in Capture One Pro (the same procedures can be applied in Lightroom/Photoshop).

Bio

In 2018, Henry Rinne retired as Dean of the College of Fine Arts at Jacksonville University in Jacksonville, Florida, after a forty-year career in higher education. Prior to his move to Florida, Henry was a dean and faculty member at the University of Arkansas-Fort Smith for 35years. He earned his Ph.D. in comparative arts at Ohio.




There were no new members this month.





























The Coral Gables Garden Club is hosting its 4th annual **AS I SEE IT Juried Nature and Wildlife Photography** competition. Please pass the information along to your club members to submit their best images. Submissions open on April 1st, 2024. The **AS I SEE IT** juried photo competition aims to increase our appreciation for the natural environment by highlighting outstanding nature and wildlife photography. This is an anonymous juried competition with three recognized judges. This year we are including Christopher Baker, the grand prize winner for our 2023 contest, who is the President of the Huntsville Photographic Society in Alabama. Our Grand Prize is \$1000, with over \$3000 in additional cash prizes for 1st and 2nd place for each of our ten categories. The money we raise from this competition goes to projects such as restoring native habitats, planting mangroves along our coastline, planting trees in public green spaces, and planting pollinator patches in schools.
