

- Settings > Wi-fi > EZ Badge (Not a problem if you see No Internet Connection)
- Open your Browser (Safari, Google, etc.)
- Type in http://ez.com Brings up EZ Badge Registration Form
- Start typing your first name...It may automatically complete your name.
- Select either Member, Board Member, or Guest
- Select Print Badge
- Select Finish

Your stick-on EZ Badge will be ready for you at the Registration table. **Turn off or Silence** your phone before entering the meeting room.
