#### IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT ABOUT COMPETITION ENTRIES

The Competitions Committee is pleased to announce a new protocol for the upcoming competition "Animals on the Move." There will still be a cap of 60 entries; however, each member will only be allowed <u>ONE</u> submission instead of two.

During the "Leading Lines" competition, we had to reject several members from entering the competition because we reached the 60 limit. We have a lot of new members who are entering the competitions and our entry numbers have grown proportionately in the last few competitions. This is a good thing-we are excited to have such enthusiastic new members who aren't just bystanders but active participants! But it means that some members will be rejected. So, to resolve this problem, we are changing the number of entries to one per member.

The one entry rule will hopefully:

- Cause less stress on the judge and perhaps enable more rounded, complete critiques.
- Give an equal footing to all members.
- Mean the galleries will stay open the entire week and not close early.
- Eliminate double ribbon winners and enable different members to win a ribbon.
- Generally, allow more members to participate in competitions.
- Bring us in line with other photography clubs who allow only one entry.
- Result in a less tedious meeting during which the judge will not have to rush through comments.

**Turn off or Silence** your phone before entering the meeting room.





































# **EXHIBITS, SHARI DUTTON**

Let's make this a great exhibit and show the community how much talent our club has! Hope


to see everyone on **September 8**<sup>th</sup> for the opening reception!
