

PRESIDENT'S NOTES – JACQUES WOOD

In this Note, I want to highlight current club activities that support the founding goals of SPC.

Expanding Understanding of Photography

We have three club activities that directly expand members' understanding of photography:

- professional presentations,
- photo competitions and
- workshops.

While we continue to have interesting/educational presentations and challenging photo competitions, this is a strong year for the workshop educational component.

The Workshop Committee, led by **Frank Lipski**, has presented **four** workshops so far. The first was on cropping photographs led by **Bonny Henderson** and **Jerry Kozel**. The second, "Creativity in Motion" and third "Lightroom Illustrated," were presented by Brian Osborne, photo educator. The fourth, "Creating a Winning Image for SPC Competitions," was coordinated by **Neva Scheve**, past President, and Stoffel winner.

Neva put together a panel of other Stoffel winners: **Gisela Danielson, Shari Dutton** and me. At this workshop on Saturday, July 22 we discussed how we created our images for competitions. Approximately one quarter of our membership (26 members) attended the workshop which had a lively discussion among the panel and attendees. Here are some comments from attendees:






November 13, 2023: Compelling Landscape Photography by Joseph Rossbach

The views are unbelievable and getting to the best lookout is very easy and not stressful walking (see a couple of shots we recently took from the top).


We will most likely stay in Mount Airy, NC, which is about 130 miles from Southern Pines. We plan to visit other areas including some beautiful vineyards






and historical sites. We want you to mark your calendar. More details will be available as the time gets closer.
