many photo adventures. Her work has appeared in a plethora of calendars, coffee-table books, and magazines worldwide, including **GEO** and **National Geographic Traveler**. Margo's photographs have won numerous awards over the years and are in private collections here and abroad. Growing up in an artistic family that exposed her to the great museums and painters of the world has given Margo a unique insight into composition and the quality of light. The energy and passion for photography that she brings to the workshops are infectious.


Her husband and partner, Arnie Zann, started his career nearly 50 years ago photographing for *LIFE* and *Time* and has been published in almost every major magazine in the world, including National Geographic, Paris Match, GEO and others. His award-winning work is in many private and museum collections including the George Eastman House in Rochester, NY. He, too, has given many workshops and seminars throughout his long career travelling the world for editorial and Fortune 100 and 500 clients. Arnie's knowledge of the zone system and dramatic lighting brings strength to his photographs. He also has an uncanny eye for what photographs will become effective black and whites.

In addition to their extensive assignment work, both Margo and Arnie have shot extensively for stock images that have appeared in advertising, corporate, and editorial venues. Their passion is making beautiful images worldwide. As Margo always says, "We can't *not* do photography."

WORKSHOPS, Linda Piechota:

BASIC PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP:

Saturday, February 21, 9-12, "**Basic Photography Workshop**" will be presented by Linda Piechota at Sandhills Community College Horticulture Welcome Center. A signup sheet will be available at the January meeting.

The workshop will introduce those relatively new to photography basic information and examples of how to achieve good Exposure, Focus and Composition, a generic "How To" for finding and using camera controls, and some of the most used Photography Terms. Weather permitting, the group will go into

the Sandhills Gardens for a hands-on lesson using the new information discussed in the workshop and will view some of the photos afterward. Participants need to bring their camera and camera manual. Manual should show evidence of having been opened. ☺

LIGHTROOM SLIDESHOW MODULE:

The third **Lightroom workshop** will be held on **Saturday, March 21**, from **9-12**, presented by Marilyn Owen, at the SCC Horticultural Center, Visitors Center. Based on the responses from the participants in the other LR workshops, this one will be on the Slideshow module, walking through the process of creating a slide show from within LR and then exporting it for sharing. This will include setting backgrounds, adding text and information, timing the transitions, and adding music. If the workshop runs short, we will have a general LR question and answer session. If you want to work along with the presentation, bring your laptop with LR installed, and have 10-20 images assembled into a LR Collection to make into your own slide show.



SOUTHERN PRALINES

Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 cups light brown sugar
- 1/8 tsp. salt
- 2/3 cup evaporated milk
- 1/2 cup pecans
- 2 Tbls. butter, melted

Directions:

- Mix sugar, salt, and milk in a large microwave dish
- Stir in melted butter
- Cover with waxed paper
- Microwave 4½ minutes
- Stir and microwave another 4½ minutes
- Stir in pecans
- Hand beat until creamy
- Drop by teaspoon on waxed paper.... COOL

There are 6 competitions planned for 2015. The ones in February, April, June, August and October will be judged by invited experts. The December competition will be an ONLINE competition judged by the members.

The topic for the February 9, 2015 competition is *Winter*. Images must relate to the season of winter, and the viewer should be able to tell that winter is the time the picture was taken. Any subject or object may be used as long as the winter theme is followed. This will be a Digital competition with Standard/Minimal post processing following Competition Manual regulations. Photographs must have been taken within the past 3 years. Two images can be submitted. We will use SmugMug, and it will be open to receive entries from **January 11, 2015 until 6 PM on January 25, 2015**. Emails will be sent out containing a link to SmugMug for entering your photos. Entrants will receive confirmation that their images have been received and are acceptable within 48 hours.

The format for the entry file names can be found in the Competition Manual at <u>www.sandhillsphotoclub.org</u>. It is very important that you exactly follow this format and that you include your name where indicated. Entries without member identification will be deleted from the competition. Also, please do not wait until the last minute to submit your entries. This will not allow any time to correct problems before the competition is closed.
